



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

- I have emailed the details of the land sale to Nelson, Oyen, & Torvik to get the contract written up. I am still waiting on that to be completed.
- I have emailed Mr. Gatchell regarding the storage units in the industrial park and I am currently waiting on a response.
- A couple of months ago Glenn Bartos came to my office and informed me that he had purchased the old telephone switchboard building behind FM bank and will be putting in some sort of business. He said he may still be interested in buying some land in the Industrial Park maybe in the next couple of years. I had let Sue know about this when it happened but thought I should address this publicly due to questions about this coming up at a council meeting recently.
- The Minnesota Economic Development Foundation has updated the EDA Handbook from the 2012 edition to the 2024 edition. I have emailed you all a copy for future reference.
